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Halloween A Hursto Presto Silhouette Painting

Pumpkin, Haunted House, Zombie

Materials

- 12" X 16" Canvas
- 8.5" X 11" Halloween Traceable
- Paint: Acrylic Black, White
- UV Flourescent Paint: Yellow, Red, Purple
- Brushes: 1.5" Chip/Gesso, #16 Medium Flat, #6 Round, Script Liner
- Easel or Paint Board/Flat Table
- Palette or Paper Plate
- Cup Water, Paper Towels/Rags
- Black Sharpie Pen, Hair Dryer
- Aprox 10" Diameter Circular Bowl/Lid



Brush sizes listed are only suggestions Use the size/type that best fits your style/inventory



1) Set your bowl/lid lowercenter of canvas and load a 1.5" gesso brush with black. Lightly paint the outer edge of the bowl/lid with black to get a clean edge.



2) Remove bowl/lid and using the same brush paint the top half black.



3) Paint the rest of the canvas solid black. Don't forget the edges.

Clean brush.



4) Dampen a sea sponge with water. Ball it up and dab it into a small amount of black.Tap in moon surface texture.Clean sponge. Let dry.



5) Load your 1.5" chip/gesso brush with white and place a thin layer over moon to lighten texture. Clean brush & let dry.



6) Once dry, load same 1.5" brush with UV yellow and paint the moon. Clean brush.



7) Load a medium flat brush with white and paint clouds above the moon.



8) Paint in white wispy smoke-like textures toward the bottom behind and below the moon. Clean brush. Let dry.




9) Once dry, load your 1.5" gesso brush with UV purple and paint the entire background purple. Clean brush.



10) Load your 1.5" gesso brush with UV yellow and paint a second coat over the moon. Merge the edge of the moon and background by overlapping. Clean brush and let dry.



11) While drying, use a black charcoal pencil/stick to rub the traceable rear side along the silhouette lines.



12) Crinkle up a dry paper towel and lightly wipe off the excess.



13) Lay your traceable lower/center canvas. Using firm pressure, trace the eyes/mouth/windows along the lines with a pen.



14) Remove the traceable and paint the eyes/mouth/windows UV red/pink. Clean brush. Let dry.



15) Once dry, lay your traceable back on your canvas and trace the pumpkin.



16) Using a sharpie, draw over the tracing to darken lines.



17) Load a medium flat brush and/or round brush with black and paint the pumpkin solid. Clean brush.



18) Using the script liner, paint in bats/birds above the pumpkin. Clean brush.



19) Load your #16 medium flat brush with black and begin painting the trees.



20) Plant your figure to the ground using horizontal left/right strokes. As you go down, use dry-brush scrubbing strokes. Don't cover all your UV purple under the figure. Clean brush.



21) Using the script liner, drag in black gnarly twigs and grassy areas.



22) Using same script liner, detail your gnarly tree with dead limbs. Clean brush.



23) Using a flat brush, touch up lower ground area with rocky textures if desired. Again, don't kill your UV purple. Clean brush.



24) Using the script liner, sign your painting with the color of your choice!







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Clean your brush often. Remember proper brush/tool care to extend its use. Thanks! Jim Hurst
