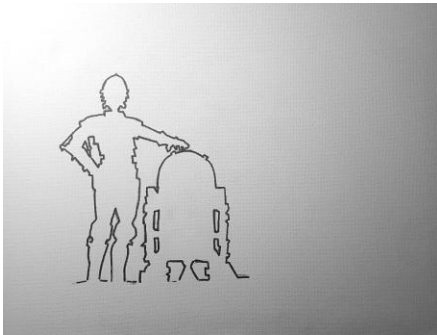
A Hursto Presto Silhouette Painting

Materials

- 12" X 16" Canvas
- 8.5" X 11" Traceable Silhouette & Transfer Paper
- Acrylic Paint: Black, White, Yellow, Red, Purple
- Brushes: 1.5" Chip, ¼" Flat, #5 Round, Script Liner
- Easel or Paint Board/Flat Table
- Palette or Paper Plate
- Jar Water, Paper Towels/Rags
- Black Sharpie Pen / Black Paint Pen



*Brush sizes listed are only suggestions.
Use the size/type that best fits your style/inventory.*



1) Silhouette: Place and trace the silhouette onto a unpainted white 12" x 16" stretched canvas. Darken lines with a black sharpie or paint pen. **Let dry.**



2) Sky. Using horizontal strokes, paint the horizon upward yellow. Blend into red above. Blend purple into red at the top edge and corners. Use yellow & white for streaky clouds. **Let dry.**



3) Foothills: Using horizontal strokes, paint the foothills various shades of purple. Thin the paint with water behind silhouette so it can show through.



4) Middle Ground: Paint the igloo and tower purple. Shade right side with even darker purple. **Let dry.**



5) Foreground: Darken your silhouette lines with a black sharpie or paint pen. Paint the silhouettes solid black with a brush.



6) Paint the ground underneath solid black for the silhouettes to stand on. Using a finger, paint the 2 moons. Don't forget your signature!
