

# Kids Sunset Silhouette A Hursto Presto Painting

#### **Materials**

Table and/or Easel 8" x 10" Canvas Flat Brush ¾" Script Liner

## **Acrylic Craft Paint**

Black Yellow Red Blue/Purple

#### Misc.

Cleaning Water Cup/Jar Small Trash Can/Bucket Paper Palette/Plate Paper Towels/Rags Hair Dryer

Tap in some Bob Ross style trees against a glowing sunset!





1) Begin by loading your ¾" flat brush with yellow. Using horizontal strokes, paint the bottom half yellow.



**2)** Without cleaning the brush, load it with red and paint the middle of canvas. Blend.



**3)** Without cleaning the brush, load it with blue or purple and paint the top of canvas. Blend. Clean brush. Let dry.



**4)** Load the same ¾" flat brush with black and pull down a thin vertical tree trunk.



**5)** Turn the brush horizontally and using the corner of the brush, tap in a tree shape.



**6)** Yep. Give him some friends, enlarging the trees as you paint outward toward the canvas edge.



**16)** Tap in some trees on the left side, and still tapping connect the two clumps of trees with a bushy horizon line. Complete the silhouette by painting the lower portion solid black.



**16)** Load a script liner with black thinned with water. Pull up little grassy areas, twigs and other shapes to add interest.

Drop in a couple 'm' birds as desired.

Don't forget to sign your painting!

### **Create A Pizza Box Easel**
